

Cabinet Secretary for Education, Dr. Fred Matiang'i inaugurated a new Council for the Kenya Institute for Curriculum Development.

The Council will now be chaired by Dr. Sarah Jerop Ruto who replaces Prof. Peter Erastus Kinyanjui.

Other members of the Council are Prof. Orpha K Ongiti, Purity Karabai Mbabu, Dr. Nicholas Kibiwott Letting, Nancy Macharia, Chief Executive Officer Teachers Service Commission (TSC)), the Chief Executive officer, Kenya National Examinations Council (KNEC) Ms. Mercy Karogo, Principal Secretary for Basic Education, Dr. Belio Kipsang, and the Principal Secretary for the National Treasury, Dr. Kamau Thugge and the Chief Executive officer of KICD, Dr. Julius Jwan.

Dr. Matiang'i asked them to bring the wealth of experience they respectively have to transform KICD in ways that will serve the educational needs of the country better.

He said they were assuming the leadership of KICD at a time when the country undertaking a curriculum reforms.

He said this provided a historic opportunity for them to steer the creation of a curriculum that will help Kenya effectively realize its aspirations as a nation.

Dr. Matiang'i also asked them to be as consultative as possible saying many people had a keen interest in education.
