THE KENYA INSTITUTE OF CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2013

(No. 4 of 2013)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development Act, 2013, the Council makes the following Regulations-

THE KENYA INSTITUTE OF CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT (COLLABORATION) REGULATIONS, 2013

- Citation. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development (Collaboration) Regulations, 2013.
- Interpretation. 2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires-
"Act" means the Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development Act 2013;
"Collaboration" means liaison between the Institute and any person or Institution for the purpose of performing the Institutes functions.
"Institute" means the Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development established under Section 3 of the Act;
- Object. 3. The object of these Regulations is to guide the establishment and maintenance of collaboration with institutions that promote the mandate of the Institute.
- Vetting. 4. The Institute shall vet programmes targeting teacher professional development related to curriculum interpretation and implementation
- Identification of Institutions and programmes. 5. The Institute shall identify-
a) institutions offering professional programmes; and
b) relevant professional development programmes for-
i) teachers;
ii) teacher trainers;
iii) quality assurance and standard officers; and
iv) other officers involved in education and training.

Collaboration with other Institutions.

6. The Institute shall liaise with-
 - a) institutions and individuals identified under these Regulations for purposes of organizing and conducting professional development programmes; and
 - b) relevant institutions to accredit teacher professional programmes for skill upgrading.

Guidelines:-

7. The Institute shall develop guidelines to enhance collaboration for professional development programmes.
8. The Institute may enter into a partnership or a collaboration agreement with such other bodies or organisation within or outside Kenya considered desirable or appropriate in furtherance of the Institute's mandate.
9. The Institute may at any time terminate a partnership or a collaboration agreement under these regulations.
