THE KENYA INSTITUTE OF CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2013

(No. 4 of 2013)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development Act, 2013, the Council makes the following Regulations-

THE KENYA INSTITUTE OF CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT (QUALITY ASSURANCE) REGULATIONS, 2013

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| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development (Quality Assurance) Regulations, 2013. |
| Interpretation | 2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires-
“Act” means the Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development Act 2013;
“Council” means the Council established under section 5 of the Act.
“Director” means Director of the Institute appointed under section 14 of the Act;
“Institute” means the Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development established under section 3 of the Act;
“monitoring” means continuous collection of data on curriculum implementation to identify success and challenges and plan interventions;
“Quality Assurance” means a system of benchmarks to ensure that the Institute maintains and improves standards on a continuous basis;
“Standards” means a level of quality or specified level of quality in development of curricula and curriculum support materials which once established shall be maintained or improved on by the Institute. |
| Object | 3. The object of these Regulations is to:
(a) assure quality and standards of curriculum and curriculum support materials
(b) establish and provide for the Quality Assurance and Standards committees. |

Quality Assurance and Standards Committee

4. There shall be a Quality Assurance and Standards Committee.

Functions of the Committee

5. The functions of the committee shall be to -

- (a) regulate the quality of curricula and curriculum support materials developed or approved by the Institute;
- (b) ensure that all curricula and curriculum support materials used in all learning institutions under the Act meet the standards and quality threshold established by the Institute.
- (c) monitor the continuous review and improvement in standards to ensure all curricula and curriculum support materials meet the set thresholds;
- (d) ensure standards and maintain quality in the departments of the Institute in regard to the development of curricula and curriculum support material;
- (e) supervise, oversee and maintain standards in curricula and curriculum support materials by-
 - (i) initiating cooperation with the other institutions, organizations or any other body or person with a view to securing the adoption and practical application of quality and standards in the development process of the development process;
 - (ii) reviewing, vetting and recommending equipment, tools and other materials necessary in the Institute for purposes of maintaining the standards set by the Institute in realizing its goals; and
 - (iii) vetting expatriates, individuals, groups and organizations and expatriates wishing to visit and work with the Institute on curriculum related matters.
