
Special Needs Education in CBC

Th e Basic Education Curriculum Framework (BECF) gives provisions for a differentiated curriculum for learners with special needs who may follow the regular curriculum with adaptations and those who may require a specialized curriculum.

Provision of a differentiated curriculum is stipulated in the sector policy for learners and trainees with disabilities (2018).
