2. Ability to access and refer to available linguistic survey reports to ensure use of authentic alphabet charts for the 18 Kenyan languages
3. Skills and capability to check for precision, naturalness and consistency in the use of words and expressions in indigenous languages.
4. Working experience including but not limited to development of learning materials in indigenous languages.
5. Demonstrated experience in developing instructional materials for Kenyan mother tongues.
6. Ability and proven experience in working with multicultural communities.
7. Familiarity with Competency Based Curriculum
8. Conversance with KICD evaluation requirements for instructional materials (print and non print)
9. An able team of designers to ensure the graphics in the materials are culture and age appropriate for the target learners.
10. Access to ethnographic survey reports to ensure editing includes reviewing concepts against acceptable cultural world view, interpretation and perception.
